WHAT: This off grid adventure is for those who want to actively participate in every aspect of their experience with the highlight being learning to run your own small team of sled dogs through miles and miles of beautiful trails in the remote wilderness of northern Minnesota. Step by step instruction is provided and there is an atmosphere of encouragement, support and team work. A lot goes into an off-grid, solar-powered lifestyle with sled dogs in a remote location and you will get to experience most aspects of it during your stay. In addition, there are numerous other activities available to you that include snow shoeing and cross country skiing. (Please bring your own equipment.)

This adventure is limited to FOUR participants so that each receives the maximum in hands-on experience and one-on-one instruction.

WHAT IF I HAVE ALREADY DONE SOME DOG SLEDDING? There is always something new to learn and every kennel does things differently! We will tailor-make your adventure based on your ability.

What to Bring: Our complete gear list, located on our website, will tell you everything you need to know to prepare yourself for the variable temperatures and conditions of winter in Northern Minnesota. Is this trip for me? If you have an adventurous spirit, love nature and the great outdoors, are open to new experiences and love the idea of spending a weekend with furry four legged friends, this trip is for you!

Can I physically do this trip? We are happy to customize a trip for anyone of any ability, however this trip requires the following: 1) You must be able to walk, snowshoe or x-country ski at least one mile. 2) You must be able to lift at least 40 lbs. 3) You must



be able to easily lift your legs 12 inches off the ground, up and over a moving object. 4)You must be able to repetitively bend over and/or kneel to perform dog care (harnessing, feeding, etc.)

Transportation: After your registration, risk waiver and deposit are received, names of other participants will be sent in case you would like to coordinate travel plans.
