WHAT: This off grid adventure is for those who want to actively participate in every aspect of their experience with the highlight being learning to run your own small team of sled dogs through miles and miles of beautiful trails in the remote wilderness of northern Minnesota. Step by step instruction is provided and there is an atmosphere of encouragement, support and team work. A lot goes into a modified off-grid, solar-powered lifestyle with sled dogs in a remote location and you will get to experience most aspects of it during your stay. In addition, there are numerous other activities available to you that include snow shoeing and cross country skiing. (Please bring your own equipment.) **This adventure is limited to FOUR participants so that each receives the maximum in hands-on experience and one-on-one instruction.**

WHAT IF I HAVE ALREADY DONE SOME DOG SLEDDING? There is always something new to learn and every kennel does things differently! We will tailor-make your adventure based on your ability.



WHAT WE HOPE YOU GAIN BY CHOOSING THIS ADVENTURE: New friends. An invigorated spirit. New winter survival knowledge. A deeper love for the outdoors. An appreciation for the historical roots of sled dog racing. A new love and understanding of sled dogs.

WHEN: **Thursday, February 4th – Sunday, February 7th OR**

WHERE: Points Unknown in the remote north woods of Hovland, MN just northeast of Grand Marais, Minnesota and within 5 ½ hours north of the Minneapolis/St. Paul Metropolitan area! The closest airports are Duluth, MN, which is 3 hours away and the Thunder Bay, Ontario International Airport which is 1.5 away.

FEE: \$1,095 per person. Fee includes THREE nights lodging in our Guest Suite, your first night's dinner, and all instruction. There is a full kitchen in the Guest Suite. To keep the pricing more affordable, we will have collaborative cooking for the rest of the meals.
This adventure is limited to 4 participants!

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ACCOMMODATIONS: You will rest in the comfort of our cozy, modified off-grid, solar- powered home situated in the remote north woods of Hovland, northeast of Grand Marais, MN. Our Guest Suite is what we call “NorthWoods Chic” with hickory floors, log walls and knotty pine ceilings. It has a large patio door window that overlooks a portion of the sled dog play area. Beautiful sunrises can be seen from this window and, if you're lucky, the aurora may appear! There is an attached bathroom with shower.

Can I physically do this trip? We are happy to customize a trip for anyone of any ability, however this trip requires the following: 1) You must be able to walk, snowshoe or x-country ski at least one mile. 2) You must be able to lift at least 40 lbs. 3) You must be able to easily lift your legs 12 inches off the ground, up and over a moving object. 4) You must be able to repetitively bend over and/or kneel to perform dog care (harnessing, feeding, etc.)

Transportation: After your registration, risk waiver and deposit are received, names of other participants will be sent in case you would like to coordinate travel plans.
