WHAT: This adventure is for those who want to experience a gentle, supported winter experience in the remote wilderness of northern Minnesota that includes:

- Being tucked into a warm and cozy dog sled and letting your musher and the dogs lead you down our breathtakingly beautiful boreal forest trails
- Snowshoeing to a frozen waterfall in a scenic river canyon
- Putting your feet up and spending relaxing evenings in our four season porch, cuddling with a sled dog
- An evening of Yoga to further ground yourself and wind down from a fulfilling day outside
- Spending time with the sled dogs during morning and evening feedings, if you wish

This experience is limited to SIX participants.



WHAT WE HOPE YOU GAIN BY CHOOSING THIS ADVENTURE: New friends. An invigorated spirit. A deeper love for the outdoors in winter. A new love and understanding of sled dogs.

WHERE: Points Unknown in the remote north woods of Hovland, MN just northeast of Grand Marais, Minnesota and within 5 ½ hours north of the Minneapolis/St. Paul Metropolitan area! The closest airports are Duluth, MN, which is 3 hours away and the Thunder Bay, Ontario International Airport which is 1.5 away.

FEE: \$695 per person. Fee includes THREE nights lodging in our Guest Suite, your first night's dinner, and all experiences. There is a full kitchen in the Guest Suite. To keep the pricing more affordable, we will have collaborative cooking for the rest of the meals. **This experience is limited to 6 participants!**

ACCOMMODATIONS: You will rest in the comfort of our cozy, modified off-grid, solar- powered home situated in the remote north woods of Hovland, northeast of Grand Marais, MN. Our Guest Suite is what we call “NorthWoods Chic” with hickory floors, log walls and knotty pine ceilings. It has a large patio door window that overlooks a portion of the sled dog play area. Beautiful sunrises can be seen from this window and, if you're lucky, the aurora may appear! There is an attached bathroom with shower. www.points-unknown.com Fall asleep to the romantic howls of the sled dogs in the otherwise still night. Two participants will be staying in our Tiny Tuloon cabin which provides the experience of a short snowshoe to the cabin with a cushy outhouse nearby. The bathroom with shower in the Guest Suite is also available for your use.
